<i>Jehovah Tsidkenu</i> (Jer. 23:5-6)	God Our Righteousness	I am forgiven of all sin (2 Cor. 5:21, Heb. 8:12, Ps. 103:3)
<i>Jehovah M’kaddish</i> (Lev. 20:8)	God Our Sanctifier	I am set apart for ministry (1 Pet. 2:9, Deut. 14:2))
<i>Jehovah Rapha</i> (Ex. 15:26)	God Our Healer	I have health & healing (Ps. 103:3)
<i>Jehovah Nissi</i> (Ex. 17:13-16)	God Our Banner of Victory	I am secure & victorious (Rom. 8:35-39, 1 Jn. 5:4-5, Rev. 12:10-11)
<i>Jehovah Shalom</i> (Jud. 6:24)	God Our Peace	I have peace & sanctuary (Jn. 14:27)
<i>Jehovah Raah</i> (Ps. 23:1)	God Our Shepherd	I am led by Holy Spirit (Rom. 8:14)
<i>Jehovah Shammah</i> (Ez. 48:35)	The Lord is There	I have God’s presence & power (Ps. 16:11)
<i>Jehovah Jireh</i> (Gen. 22:14)	God Our Provider	I have success & provision (2 Cor. 9:8, 2 Pet. 1:3, Jn. 10:10)
