

Words have power.

***“The tongue has the power of life and death,
and those who love it will eat its fruit.” (Proverbs 18:21)***



The spoken word carries substance. In the story of creation, God created everything in existence with his words and we are created in his image. Adam’s first assignment was using words. The Bible tells us there is life and death in the power of the tongue (Proverbs 18:21). Words are powerful. We must be careful of the words we speak. Whatever you agree with, you empower in your life. Job 22:28 says, *“You shall decree a thing, and it shall be established for you; And light shall shine upon your ways.”* When you speak in agreement with God’s will and the words of heaven over your life, you empower God to work on your behalf. When you speak in agreement with the words of Satan over your life, you empower him to carry out the assignment on those words.

Let’s bring our words in line with the things that God is saying. Let’s start calling those things that are not as though they are (Romans 4:17). When we speak in line with the will of God, we will see circumstances begin to be transformed. Focus on coming into agreement with the Word of God. The declarations on the following pages are a starting point. Speak them over yourself, your family, and your circumstances. As you read and study the word, take promises that you read and turn them into your own declarations. God loves you and longs to have your partnership with him in empowering heaven over your life.

- My prayers are powerful and effective. (James 5:16)
- I am the righteousness of God in Christ. (2 Corinthians 5:21)
- I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me. (Philippians 4:13)
- I am full of grace and power. (Acts 6:8)
